Welcome to North Hollywood High School!

You're invited to our summer band practice. These practices are intended to get a head start on learning our music for the fall semester. During Band Camp, future members of our Band and Dance Team will also learn the basics of being in a marching group and further prepare themselves for the semester ahead.

If you own your instrument you will need to bring it to practice the first day, otherwise we will provide one for you. You should also wear tennis shoes and comfortable clothes. If you are unable to attend due to prior commitments, we still invite you to participate in band this fall and attend the practices you are able to attend.

Our annual Band Camp is scheduled for Monday through Friday, August 15th to August 26th from 2:30 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. in the music room. We use this schedule to minimize the number of trips parents must make to drop you off and to take advantage of the cooler temperatures in the afternoon and evening. "A" track classes start on Monday, August 29.

Most schools that we compete against have a three-week Band Camp as well as practices all through the summer. We believe that we can accomplish what is necessary in just 2 weeks, get to know one another, and have a lot of fun.

During Band Camp we will have a number of breaks and will eat dinner together. You should plan on bringing \$5.00 each day for dinner.

Students who attend Band Camp will receive Intersession (Summer School) credit for attending Band Camp. You may have received a letter from the school telling you about Advanced Band Intersession. This was not supposed to be sent to you and you may ignore it.

Part of the agreement we have with our administration is that the students whose track was changed to be in music will fully participate in extra practices and activities. Any student whose track was changed and who does not attend Band Camp or who schedules out of music will be returned to their originally assigned track on August 29.
